39th ANNUAL HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP SHOW & SENIOR PORTFOLIO COMPETITION

March 4 – 22, 2012

Receiving: Thurs. Feb. 9, 1– 4pm & Fri/Sat. Feb. 10/11, Noon – 3pm

Opening Reception: Sun. March 4, 4 – 6pm

Pickup: Thurs. through Sat. March 22 -24, Noon – 3pm

Eligibility: High School juniors and seniors from Stamford, Greenwich, Darien, New Canaan, Norwalk, Wilton, Weston, Westport, Fairfield and Ridgefield interested in pursuing a career in the arts. PORTFOLIO COMPETITION for seniors only. Work must have been executed within the past two years. This is a juried show with awards ranging from merchant gift certificates to cash prizes.

Requirements: NO MORE THAN EIGHT STUDENTS per school are eligible, due to space restrictions. This is a professionally juried show, so please fill out forms legibly.

2D Work: 40 x 60" high maximum; 11 x 14" minimum size. All wall work must be neatly framed and ready-to-hang with a secure wire backing. Lightweight Plexiglas frames are preferred, with two eyehooks on the back and a strong wire threaded through both.

3D Work: Sculpture, ceramics, fiber, mixed media up to 60 lbs. The SAA will supply pedestals.

Teachers: Please try and drop off the student work with an adult volunteer(s) on any of the receiving dates mentioned above. Remind the students of the dates and times for the opening reception and pick-up. Food and non-alcoholic beverages are welcomed for the reception and donations from area merchants are needed for the student prize awards.

We usually have excellent press coverage, so please make sure that you have at least one representative at the opening reception to accept any possible awards. *Please pre-select the eight students and have them fill out the ARTIST RELEASE FORM, WALL CARD IDENTITY LABELS (2) and PORTFOLIO CONTENTS FORM (seniors only)*
