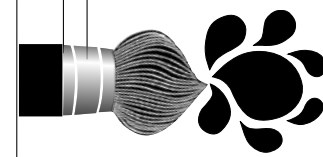

ELIGIBILITY- Original work in any medium, created in the last 3 years and not exhibited previously in the Faber Birren Show.

SUBMISSIONS- Labeled 35mm slides (indicate top of work, name, title, size) or CD (jpg images up to 8", 300dpi)

ENTRY FEE

A non-refundable fee of \$20.00 per entry for non-members and \$15.00 per entry for members. Check or money order payable to the Stamford Art Association must accompany entry. Unlimited entries are permitted. Prospectus can be photocopied to accommodate additional entries. (One entry form per artwork submitted).

SIZE AND WEIGHT

Dimensions not to exceed 60" high x 48" wide including frame. All paintings must be wired and ready to hang. Three dimensional pieces must not exceed 60 pounds and 60" high, 40" wide and 24" deep. Work exceeding these dimensions will not be displayed.

DELIVERY

Instructions for shipping, handling fees, labels and hand deliveries will accompany acceptance letters mailing week of Aug. 24.

Accepted work must be received by shipping agent Mariano Brothers. by Sept. 8, 2008. Handling fees (approx. \$55 per artist) and shipping charges are artist's responsibility.

Accepted works may be hand-delivered on Friday, September 12, 2008 (Noon - 3pm) Saturday, September 13, 2008 (Noon - 3pm)


