



SENIOR PORTFOLIO COMPETITION

Eligibility: High School seniors from Stamford, Greenwich, Darien, New Canaan, Norwalk, Wilton, Weston, Westport, Fairfield and Ridgefield who will be attending an art school or majoring in art at a college or university. Work must have been executed within the last two years and be ready-to-display in a neat and professional manner inside an artist portfolio.

Awards: This is a juried show. Jurors are paid professionals. The scholarship awards range from \$100 to \$1,000. Students must submit proof to the SAA by submitting a photocopy of their college acceptance letter by the end of the year. *(Awards not claimed by December 31st of this calendar year, will revert back to the SAA for future student shows.)*

Requirements: No more than 8 portfolios per school may be submitted due to space restrictions. Each portfolio may contain up to 10 pieces, matted neatly. One of those pieces should be ready-to-hang in a lightweight plexi-glass (preferred) frame with eyehooks and a strong wire securely fastened to the back. 3D work can be photographed for the portfolio, with one of those pieces ready-for-display on a (SAA supplied) pedestal. *Student work not deemed suitable for display may be rejected.*

Teachers: Please inform the students of the dates and times for drop-off, opening reception and pick-up. We usually have excellent press coverage, so please make sure that you have at least one representative at the opening reception to accept any possible awards. *Please pre-select the 8 students and have them fill out the ARTIST RELEASE FORM legibly and place the PORTFOLIO INVENTORY form inside their portfolios.*
